#### Babies and Toddlers

Babies and Toddlers meet on Thursdays and Fridays from 9.45am to 11.45am in the Main Hall during school term-time. Our mornings include playing with toys, tabletop activities, singing songs, and a chance to chat with other parents.

#### Nile Grove Playgroup

Nile Grove Playgroup is a fun place for children to take their first steps towards independence. We accept children from 2½ to 5 years of age. Sessions are 9.15am–11.45am, Mon, Tues, Wed, Fri during term time. Website: www.nilegroveplaygroup.co.uk

#### Greenbank Pre School

We are a friendly and established community provider of pre-5 education offering both morning and afternoon sessions. #### Messy Church

Messy Church is for children and their families. We have crafts, games, songs and a Bible Story, and then we share a meal together! Messy Church is free and friends, brothers and sisters are welcome. #### Holiday Club

We also enjoy occasional fun outings. Whether you come every Sunday or you've never been before, everyone is welcome at Springboard! We meet in the Pentland Room.



The QII programme is usually based on Bible study, exploring questions raised by the young people themselves. They also enjoy games and fun activities together. They are keen to become more involved in the life of the congregation and have offered various aspects of service in the past few months – serving food at events, helping with Holiday Club, Messy Church, etc. They are looking at new ways of moving forward in the coming year.
